

# After School Sports TERM 4 2017

In Term 4 2017 and Term 1 2018, the following sports will be offered as part of East Adelaide School's After School Sport Program.

### **Sports Teams**

Sports Teams are for Year 2 to 7 students to develop skills through training once a week before/after school and participating in competitive games.

Offered in Terms 4 & 1 are the following sports:

• Basketball (Terms 4 & 1)

Offered in Term 4 only are the following sports:

- Cricket (Term 4 only)
- Volleyball (Term 4 only)

Closing date for all Sports Registrations is Thursday 7th September

# **Sports Teams offered in Terms 4 &1**

### Basketball - Years 2 to 7

The Basketball competition runs at MARS Sporting Complex (Lower Portrush Road, Marden), throughout Terms 4 and 1 in 2017/18. Games can be scheduled from 4:00pm to 5:20pm.

Year 2/3 Thursday Afternoon games
Year 4/5 Tuesday Afternoon games
Year 6/7 Wednesday Afternoon games

As the Basketball season is across the school years, if registration numbers permit, we will place all the Year 7 students together in a team that concludes at the end of Term 4.

Cost: Basketball Term 4 and Term 1 Fees Years 2-6 \$150
Basketball Term 4 Fees Year 7 \$90

### Cricket - Years 2 to 7 (TERM 4 ONLY)

Students participate in the Kensington Primary School Cricket competition. Matches are played every week during the cricket season. Where registration numbers permit, teams are entered into each of the following age groups: Kanga (Year 2 and 3), Grade C (Year 4 and 5), Grade B (Years 5 and 6) and Grade A (Years 6 and 7). East Adelaide plays modified matches against other local primary schools at various oval locations.

Saturday morning Kanga matches, 1 hour duration. Year 2/3 (Kanga)

Kanga Cricket is a fun introduction to the game for boys and girls, with a high emphasis placed on fun and maximum participation

\* Please note Year 1 students can register to play in Kanga cricket matches, if the

parents/caregivers feel that their child is advanced and ready for competition.

Year 4/5 (C Grade) Friday afternoon matches

Junior Cricket is a modified cricket game with a high emphasis placed on skill

development and equal participation.

Year 5/6 (B Grade) Saturday morning matches

Junior Cricket is also a modified cricket game with a high emphasis placed on skill

development and equal participation.

Year 6/7 (A Grade) Saturday morning matches

Senior Cricket is advanced cricket games for older students.

### PLEASE NOTE: CHILDREN WHO REGISTERED AND PLAYED CRICKET IN TERM 1, DO NOT NEED TO RE-REGISTER FOR TERM 4.

### **Volleyball - Years 4 to 7 (TERM 4 ONLY)**

Students participate in "Spikezone" which is a modified rules game tailored for fun and development. The teams are made up of 4 to 6 players and can be all girls or mixed teams.

Games are played each Thursday afternoon between 4:30-5:30pm at the Aquatics and Recreation Centre (ARC), 531 Lower North East Road, Campbelltown.

There are approximately 7-8 games in each term.

The competition is run by the Norwood Bears Volleyball Club which provides a great coaching element to the games, therefore beginners to the sport are well supported.

Term 4 Fee Cost: Year 4 – 7 \$70

# **Registration Details**

# Closing date for Sports Registrations is Thursday 7th September

Registration and payment is required prior to the closing date to ensure your child's placement in a team. Players registering after the closing date will have their names placed on a waiting list and are not guaranteed a place.

Team nominations are dependent upon the availability of coaches, parent volunteers and player numbers. Therefore, if there are insufficient registrations for any given sport, or if no one comes forward to coach, a team cannot be formed. In these circumstances, registration fees will be credited to the family's school account.

Fees cover all costs associated with conducting the After School Sports program at East Adelaide School. However, fees do not cover the loss or damage of any uniform or sporting equipment supplied by the school and parents will be invoiced for the replacement of these items.

Registration fees are only refunded when there is not a place in a team for your child or for medical reasons once play commences.

Refunds are not made should a parent / carer withdraw their child from the assigned team. Usually refunds are made in the form of a school credit.

### **Parent / Carer Volunteers**

East Adelaide School greatly appreciates parents / carers who are able to volunteer time to support our After School Sport program. Each team requires a coach, a team manager, scorers to assist at practises and games. Please complete the Parent Volunteer Form if you are able to volunteer in any capacity. Without the assistance of volunteers, sporting teams cannot be formed.

It is mandatory that all volunteers at East Adelaide School attend Volunteer Training. It is also recommended that volunteers complete their Department for Communities and Social Inclusion (DCSI) Clearance Checks. Forms are available in the Front Office and the cost for these is paid for by the school.

### **Team Selection**

The process of allocating players to teams involves consultation between the After School Sports Coordinator, teachers and coaches. While parent preferences are taken into consideration, the complexities of forming teams and considering the needs of all players means that individual preferences sometimes are not met.

Allocation to teams is based on -

- Age of player
- Experience in the chosen sport
- Nominated Friends (maximum of two)
   NB: Nominating friends does not guarantee placement in the same team. If your child is not placed with one of their nominated friends, however, you will be contacted by the After School Sports Coordinator to talk this through with you.

### The After School Sports Coordinator has the final decision on team composition.

Once player allocations are finalised, students will be notified of their sporting team. A note regarding coaches, team allocations, practice sessions and match times will be sent home as soon as this information is available.

#### **Uniforms**

Details regarding uniform will be provided once the After School Sports Coordinator has notified children of their team placements. As a general guideline, EAS After School Sports loans each registered player a playing top and parents are required to purchase shorts/pants, socks, protection equipment and shoes. Please do not purchase any uniform items before your child receives their team placement information, as this will have specific details on your child's uniform requirements.

### **Fee Payments and Uniforms**

The Cashier/Uniform Shop in the School Foyer is available for payment of all sports fees and uniform purchases at the following times:

Tuesday – Thursday 8:30 – 9:15am Tuesday 3:15 – 3:45pm

The Cashier/Uniform Shop is not open on Mondays and Fridays.

Alternatively, you can pay sports registration fees and purchase uniform items online via our QKR App. However, all relevant forms must also be submitted to the Cashier/Uniform Shop for registration to be complete.

Should you have difficulty paying the scheduled fees by the closing date, please discuss this with the After School Sports Coordinator or the Business Manager.

### **Team Trainings**

Times for team training cannot be confirmed until all teams are formed. Training details are included when players are notified of their team, coach, etc.

### **Konnective App**

After School Sport updates are regularly send out on the school's Konnective App. Please ensure you download this application, so that you are aware of any upcoming events and changes to After School Sport. The school newsletter is another good source of information, so please ensure you read this to keep up to date with the latest news.

### **Sport Trophies and Certificates**

In 2017, East Adelaide School is awarding individual trophies to students who participate in sports teams from Year 2 to Year 7. The cost of the trophies is included in the sport fee.

Trophies will be presented at the relevant Sports Presentation Night. Invitations will be sent to individual students regarding this night.
