

EAST ADELAIDE SCHOOL ASSET AND LANDSCAPE COMMITTEE ROLE STATEMENT

The East Adelaide School Asset and Landscape Committee is a sub-committee of the East Adelaide School Governing Council. This sub-committee is a forum for consultation related to the establishment of the Outdoor Master Plan.

Membership of the Asset and Landscape Sub- Committee includes:

- The Principal or representative of the leadership team
- A member of Governing Council
- Parents/Carers

The Asset and Landscape Committee identifies and elects a chairperson and secretary.

Meeting times:

Meeting times are agreed based on what is mutually convenient for members. Historically the meetings have been on an agreed to day, twice per term, for no more than one hour.

The role of the subcommittee is to:

- Assist the Governing Council to meet the requirements of the DfE Assets and Outdoor Learning and Play Areas requirements
- Support and assist the Governing Council, Principal/or delegate to ensure that the design and maintenance guidelines are in keeping with the values, principles and policies of the school, council, community and DfE, for example Outdoor Learning Areas Protocol and Playgrounds Fact Sheet
- Advocate for, represent and ensure that children, families and staff have a voice in the establishment and management of projects such as those outlined in the Master Plan
- Committee meetings discuss, research, analyse and make recommendations in the best interests of the staff, children, families and community to the Governing Council for ratification
- The Committee reports to each Governing Council meeting on matters relating to progress reports and monitoring processes on Landscape Masterplan projects
- Meetings are recorded appropriately
- Information about outdoor projects, working bees etc. are reported regularly in the school newsletter and Konnective
- Organises working bees to help out with gardening and maintenance
