

Volunteer Role Description After School Sports

Aims of the role

To develop each student:

- social skills and confidence
- ability to play as part of a team
- individual skills in the sport
- knowledge of sports rules and sportsmanship enjoyment of the sport.

What you need before you start

As well as the usual minimum requirements in the Department for Education volunteer policy and procedure, you must have:

- a way for people to contact you when you volunteer (e-mail, text, phone)
- easy access to a first aid kit and relevant medical details of students
- a basic kit is provided by the school.

Supervision and Safety

Volunteers have a duty of care to ensure the safety and wellbeing of children by responsibly supervising their activities at all times. You will need to ensure that:

- everyone is safe
- students go to the toilet in pairs
- you can be contacted by the sports coordinator, leadership team, parents and caregivers
- have the names and contact details of students and their parents or caregivers (provided by the school)
- always have another adult present (a parent or caregiver of one of the students)
- know who the students can leave with and wait with them until they are collected
- contact school staff if you can't contact parents or caregivers

- have the mobile number of the sports coordinator, and a method of contacting the school
- training and games to occur only at agreed/published times and at areas determined by the school and competition venue
- promptly reporting any concerns, incidents, or observations directly to the volunteer coordinator or a member of school leadership.

What we expect from you

- uphold our school values of Respect, Responsibility, Relationships and resilience
- treat everyone fairly and with respect. This includes ensuring all children get equal playing time in all positions no matter their ability
- include students of all abilities, ages, genders, and ethnic backgrounds.
- be a good role model for the students.
- show enthusiasm and enjoyment – make it fun
- Communicate any issues as soon as practical.
